RULES & REGULATIONS**

Friday Evening Gates Open at 6:00 pm
Each Vendor must be setup and ready on Friday evening by 5:00 pm
Booths must remain open until the dance starts.
Vendors are welcome to stay open later at their option.

Saturday Park Gates Open at 8:00 a.m.
Vendors must be completely setup by 10:00 a.m.
Booths must remain open until the dance starts.
Vendors are welcome to stay open later at their option.

Space size will be 10' X 10'

- All Vendors are required to bring their own canopy and display tables.
- All items must be HAND MADE OR HAND EMBELLISHED by you to be considered a non-commercial booth. Any vendor found selling merchandise that they did not handcraft or hand embellish at the \$25.00 per booth fee will pay the commercial flat fee of \$50.00 per booth or will be asked to leave the park with no refund of fees.
- Vendors requiring electricity will be charged an additional fee of \$25.00.
- All vehicles must be off festival area and in designated worker's parking by set up time each day. There are limited worker's gate admission and vehicle passes.
- Vendors must submit photos of items to be sold with application.
- Booths will be assigned on a *first-come first-served basis or by your items*.
