Registration

- Player will sign in and receive their \$5,000.00 chip ticket
- Bonus Chips: If registered before August 10th, bonus chips of \$1,000 will be issued at no extra charge. If registered after August 10th or on the day of the tournament bonus chips of \$1000 can be purchased for \$20.00
- Give ticket to dealer at start of tournament to receive your chips
- One re-buy may be purchased during the first hour of play. Player can either purchase \$10 (\$1000 in chips), \$25 (\$2500 in chips), or \$50 (\$5000 in chips). No more re-buys after 11:00 A.M.

General Tournament Info

- Tournament is from 10:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. There is no assigned seating.
- Tournament instruction will start at 9:50, with tournament to begin at 10:00 a.m.
- This is a 3 hour tournament. No cheating, no sharing chips and no helping others.
- When you are out of chips, please leave table so Pit Boss can see which players are still in tournament
- Blinds will start at \$25.00 and \$50.00, and will be increased throughout play.
- No ante the whole game.
- No "String Bets"---placing a bet and then adding to it.
- Player must say "raise" before putting bet out, or it is a "call"
- Check-raise is allowed.
- A raise must be at least the amount of the previous bet.
- The Big Blind will always be the minimum bet.
- Unlimited betting
- If a player leaves the table, and they are the Big or Small blind, the dealer will put out the blind for the player, and deal the player into the hand. If player returns to the table before the play gets to them, they may play their cards. If play gets to the player before they return, the dealer will fold the player's hand
- There will be side pots
- Breaks are scheduled throughout the morning. During this time, if needed, the dealer will color up your chips
- Tables will be consolidated as needed.
- The Final Table will consist of the 9 top players with prizes awarded to all finishers.
